












How Can I Revise?

	Explain and Describe Explain a topic to a friend or write it down using as much detail as possible
	Dual Coding Use pictures and words together to help you remember. Remember, quick sketches are best!
	Mind-Mapping Create a diagram in which information is represented visually, usually with a central idea placed in the middle and associated ideas arranged around it
	PiXL Apps Use PiXL Lit , PiXL Geography and PiXL History on your mobile phones or computer
	GCSE Pod and MathsWatch Use these revision tools, online, to help your revision. Download pods to help you remember key information and MathsWatch to help you practise your skills!
	Self-Quizzing Use look/cover/write/check to see what you can remember about topics. Or try using online quizzes on BBCBitesize or Kahoot to test yourself
	Flash Cards Put a short answer on one side and an explanation on the other...
	Thinking Hard and PiXL Independence Use the PiXL worksheets to organise what you need to learning.
	Spaced Practice Divide each topic into short chunks and revise a little every day
	Interleaving Swap between topics instead of studying one subject in big blocks
