

Year 11 'Final Day' - 7th June 2021

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to let you know that **Monday 7th June will be your child's last full day of face to face and on-site learning**. They will have an opportunity on that day to celebrate their time at Beacon High with their peers, with shirt signing and a Leavers Assembly after lunch. **All Year 11s will be escorted off-site at 2.00pm on that day.**

The reason for this decision is that all assessments and evidence of learning have now been submitted and we cannot accept any further evidence to support TAGs (Teacher Assessed Grades). However, we are offering **provision and support for two weeks** following the half-term that includes **lectures, key skills, A Level Taster sessions and a core of PE and PSHCE** lessons. Please see attached the schedule for this provision from **Tuesday 8th June to Friday 18th June**. This is important as these sessions will support your child's transition into Post-16 education.

Your child can physically attend school for the timetabled Core PE and PSHCE lessons should they wish to; your child will need to leave the site immediately after these lessons. All other sessions will be offered remotely via Google Meets. The lead teacher will send an invitation at the start of each session and Year 11s who wish to join/opt in can do so.

We hope that your child enjoys their 'final day' with us. We will miss them! We would also like to praise them wholeheartedly for the manner in which they have navigated their GCSE courses with the twists and turns that have taken place since the start of the pandemic. Also, their commitment since March 24th has been fantastic!

I will write to you before the summer holidays with details about **Results Day on Thursday 12th August** and how we will be running this event. Your child will be invited in for a meeting with an allocated member of staff on that day to discuss the grades that they have been awarded as TAGs.

If you have any questions in the meantime, please do not hesitate to contact us.

Finally, thank you for your support, commitment and for bearing with us through the updates and changes that have had to be made as a result of the pandemic and Government guidance. We really do appreciate this.
