Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to invite you to your first Year 7 Parents' Evening on **Wednesday 23rd June, 2021 from 4.00pm to 6.00pm**. This will be a very important opportunity for you to meet with your child's subject teachers to discuss their progress and their commitment to learning so far at Beacon High School. You will also receive their latest Progress Report during this evening.

The Government roadmap indicates that all restrictions are due to be lifted on Monday 21st June. This will allow us to hold this Parents' Evening in the usual manner, where you will be able to come into school and have face-to-face meetings with all your child's subject teachers. For safety, we will encourage you to wear face coverings/masks at all times and ensure that your hands are sanitised when entering and exiting the building (hand sanitiser will be available).

Please note that all meetings will be face-to-face unless you request otherwise. We recognise that some parents/carers may wish to continue to follow social distancing restrictions so therefore we will offer phone meetings with an allocated member of staff who will be able to discuss your child's report. Please note the member of staff contacting you will not be their subject teacher. If you wish to opt for a phone call please contact the school as soon as possible. Calls will be made any time between 4.00pm - 6.00pm; where possible I will allocate you a 15 minute time slot.

If you as the parent/carer, or your child/ren are ill or displaying any of the symptoms of coronavirus, please do not attend the face to face meeting. Let the school know in the normal way you would to report an absence, and ring NHS 119.

I look forward to welcoming you on **Wednesday 23rd June, 2021**. **If there are any changes to current Government policy we will write and update you about any adapted plans or changes that we need to make for this event.**
